Speaker Steve Calhoun, Health Alliance underwriter:

Steve Calhoun talked about the renewal coming up in September. After 6 months, the trust has \$1,244,140.88 to pay estimated claims of \$1,112,134.04, leaving \$132,006.84 excess in reserve money to date. Steve recommended moving back the renewal to October and go with a 15 month rate. He suggested the group should receive a 8.50% increase at renewal and the schools remaining in their current tier.
