There were a few human errors in the ded/OOPM accumulators, and they should be corrected by the end of the day. School additions to the trust -11/1 Mascoutah, Harmony-Emge and Shelbyville and 12/1 Tuscola and Anna District #37. Deb Simmons went over the Blue Insight Report and the group is running well. Average discount is 55.3% and there are currently 10 high-cost claimants. Carle bills are getting updated – we believe Carle was billing members before running it through insurance.
