Financials:

Bismarck-Henning CUSD #1 made the motion and Heritage Community Unit School District #8 seconded the motion to approve financials through May 25, 2023. Medical claims for the month are \$103.45 and administration fees are \$1,340.00 so total expenses are \$1,443.45. Balance in the trust account is \$1,477,691.86 and wellness account is \$173,929.07.

- **Discussion on TPA for HRA, COBRA and Flex administration:** Originally the trust used BPC for its COBRA, HRA and Flex administration and then moved to TCOH effective 1.1.22. Brian Loman along with his team evaluated 3 companies to possibly handle the COBRA, HRA and Flex administration effective 1.1.24. After their evaluation, Brian Loman decided to bring in isolved to come and present to the executive board.
- Speakers from isolved Cam Ellis, Lars Knudsen, Mike Flannery & Stu Story: isolved started in COBRA administration and branched out to administrating HRA and Flex plans. They are a trusted partner with 22,000 brokers and big enough to deliver technology support for clients at any size and small enough to tailor their service to their client's unique needs. They have a dedicated service team and provide quarterly reviews and administration credit if they don't perform up their standard performance. They have integrations established with BCBS and Employee Navigator.
- BCBS update Ainsley McDaniel: Ainsley McDaniel provided numbers for chiropractic claims and urgent care. Chiropractic claims are being charged towards the deductible/coinsurance. This should be an easy fix at renewal to apply the \$25 copay. There were 68 claims that applied a \$75 copay for Urgent Care (1 copay \$25 and 1 copay \$50). The fix for this is to potentially lower the copay for UC from \$50 to \$25 and this would ensure that the claims would be billed correctly. This fix could cause a pretty nominal increase to the renewal, so Jeremy Darnell requested Ainsley to see how much impact this change is going to affect the renewal.
- Nurse Navigator update Kris Elliot: Kris Elliot is currently working through claims with members who have been accidentally billed out-of-network for services done at Carle. These issues are becoming less as the year progresses.

Discuss and vote on 2022 audit:

Salt Fork CUSD #512 made the motion and Bismarck-Henning CUSD #1 second the motion to approve the 2022 audit. There were no findings.
